

## **AIR TRAFFIC FLOW MANAGEMENT UPDATE 8**

Internal operational validation of the Enhanced Air Traffic Flow Management System is still earnestly in progress. In tandem CAMU is actively training existing and new staff to the exciting world of ATFM. The final testing and dataset updates are planned for April 2010. The enhanced ATFM service will be operational from on the 3 May 2010.

### **Areas subjected to ATFM**

The CAMU may apply ATFM Measures to flights which:

Depart, or arrive: Johannesburg (FAJS), Cape Town (FACT), Durban (FADN), Bloemfontein (FABL), Lanseria (FALA), George (FAGG), Port Elizabeth (FAPE), East London (FAEL), and Kruger Mpumalanga Intl Airport (FAKN). Other aerodromes and airspaces within the Johannesburg and Cape Town FIRs may be subjected to ATFM as well;

and/or;

Entering the Johannesburg and Cape Town, Oceanic FIRs after departing from an adjacent Flight Information Region (FIR) within the ATFM adjacent area.

### **ATC Slots:**

The Enhanced Air Traffic Flow Management System will be issuing ATC slots for the 3 coordinated airports nl. FAJS, FACT and FALE daily based on the airport slots. This will enable Aircraft Operators to manage their slots online on the day of operational. Compliance with ATC slots is mandatory. Once the need for *traffic management initiatives (TMIs) to put in place then the ATC slots at the 3 coordinated airports* may be revised based on the severity of problem, also other aerodromes or airspaces (FCA- flow constraint areas) could become subjected to ATFM.

### **CAMUWEB Registration:**

Aircraft operators and airports must complete the CAMU WEB registration form attached to gain access to the CAMU WEB. ATS units will receive their login/passwords by the 15 April 2010.
